

The Largest Network of Marine Research Institutions in Europe

EuroMarine is a professional Network of over 60 marine organisations and research institutes from 22 countries.

Since its launch in 2014, the Network has supported the identification and initial development of important emerging topics and associated methodologies in marine sciences and has fostered new services relevant to the marine scientific community. The Network also facilitates funding, training, networking and other opportunities for its members. Early Career Researchers (ECRs) are supported through OYSTER, an independent working group funded by the Network.

The Network acts as an advocacy organisation for marine science, providing expert advice to support and influence European marine policy. The Network's members can then amplify their voice and influence by working together.

Impact



Benefits for Members

The **EuroMarine** Network is open to European academic or research institutes that are active in marine sciences (Full members), as well as academic or research organisations outside of Europe, notably from developing countries (Invited members). The Network ensures greater visibility, benefits and tools for marine scientists and their institutions. Members can apply at an organisational level – anyone affiliated with a member organisation can be is considered an individual member and will be included in the Network's extensive database. **EuroMarine** membership provides specific advantages for both organisations and individuals.
